

Advanced Placement Course Contract: European History

It is the belief of Buncombe County Schools that all students who are willing to accept the challenge of a rigorous academic curriculum should be considered for enrollment in Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Each student who plans to register for an AP course should understand the requirements outlined below. Both parent and student should review and sign this AP Course Enrollment Contract. Each student must understand and or agree to the following AP course registration guidelines and requirements:

1. The College Board provides guidelines on curricular and resource requirements for AP courses. Each college or university determines criteria for awarding college credit for an AP course.
2. Students may be required to complete an AP Summer Assignment for an AP course. If so, the assignment will be given to students as part of class information material. Notification of the assignments will be given to students before summer break. Students who do not come by to pick up any class information but want to take the course will be responsible for getting the AP Summer Assignment information from Mr. Boyd or Mr. Feid in counseling prior to summer vacation. **The AP Summer Assignment (if assigned) will be graded. Students who register for AP courses in the spring must return the AP Summer Assignment (if assigned) on the first day of school. Students, who enroll in school after the first day of school, will receive the AP Summer Assignment (if assigned) on the day of registration and will have to complete and submit the work.**
3. Students enrolled in an AP course **must** take The College Board's AP course examination given in May. There is a fee for this examination. For students who may have financial difficulties in meeting the cost, support may be available.
4. **Schedule changes will not be made! Once enrolled in the course students will be unable to change to another course.**

5. **Course textbook will be provided.** Any additional readings, novels or texts needed must be obtained by the student enrolled in the course for use throughout the semester. **This includes a suggested AP European History AP test preparation book**, which can be obtained at any Barnes & Noble or through Amazon.com.
6. **Tests are not curved nor is “extra” credit given. Students earn the grade they receive.**
7. Student must understand, be aware, and agree that if scheduling of this course places it in the fall semester the **student must attend scheduled review sessions in the spring before the AP test is given during SMART period**
8. Students will be expected to be able to access the course via CANVAS to keep up with posted assignments, links, readings, and to generate discussions.
