Pre Requisite of Visual Arts Beginning/Art One

In this class students will be exposed to a Film Single Lens Reflex camera. Students will learn how to use a manual film camera to develop their own film. Students will also learn how to work in a darkroom to develop their own photographic prints. Students will also be exposed to Digital media. Where they will learn to use a digital SLR camera along with computer photo editing software. Would be beneficial to own your own digital SLR.

All students are required to purchase their own Film SLR camera. These can range from \$150 to \$300 depending on what kind and where you purchase it. Students must be able to purchase their own film and photographic paper. Students will need to purchase at least 10 rolls of black and white film, which range from \$6 to \$7 at Ball Photo supply store. Along with film students are required to purchase their own photographic paper. This price is normally around \$35. If the student or parent feels they cannot afford these supplies then this class is not the best choice for that student.

Students need to be motivated and willing to think outside the box. Students must be willing to drive and go to new places to complete some assignments. This class takes time to go outside and photograph people, places and or objects depending on assignment requirements.
